Efforts to degrade our local democracy



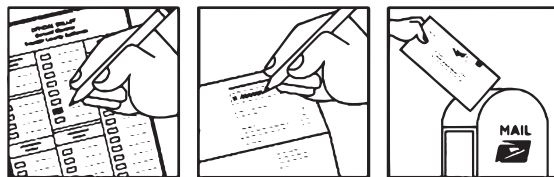
